

e-Learning Fundamentals course

Introduction

This short international course is designed and developed by an international consortium of e-Learning specialists. The project is funded by the European Commission. The course gives you an excellent, and free opportunity to learn about e-learning. You will meet online and exchange experiences with other international learners. Your only investment will be your time and energy. No costs are involved. The course is however part of a development project and we will therefore be asking you to provide us with feedback on your experience of the course. The insights on intercultural learning will be shared (anonymously) with the community.

Goal of the course

After finishing this course you will:

- be able to discuss the principal elements of e-Learning;
- be able to identify best practices and pitfalls in this kind of learning;
- have developed an awareness of the relevant issues in e-Learning for your own organization;
- have developed a clear vision on implementing e-Learning in your own organization.

Subjects

The course focuses on the following subjects:

- Basics of e-Learning.
- Building an e-Learning course.
- Communication and collaboration.
- Tools and environments.
- Innovations and trends.

Time investment & scheduling

The course will have a duration of 6 weeks. Each week will require 2 hours of your time for learning, at any moment that is convenient for you. The total course will take 12 hours plus 30 minutes for providing feedback.

The course will start on May 21st and will end on June 30th.

Target group

This course will interest you if you want to learn about the fundamental issues about e-Learning, and how to use this knowledge in your own situation, whatever that may be (corporate, public, etc.).

The learners on this course will be students, teachers, trainers, course developers or training managers. In general you will get most out of the course if you have a limited prior knowledge in the field of e-Learning, but you know how to use an Internet browser without any problems. Prior knowledge of didactics (the art of teaching) is welcome.

Certificate

Every learner who has successfully finished the course will receive an official certificate issued by FORTH (Foundation for Research and Technology-Hellas in Greece).
